

## COMPLAINT FOR ADVERSE POSSESSION

CAUSE OF ACTION
(Quiet Title By Adverse Possession Against)
1. Plaintiff [name] is, and at all times mentioned in this complaint
was, a resident of County, California.
2. Defendant [name] is, and at all times mentioned in this complaint
was, a resident of County, California.
3. Plaintiff does not know the true names of defendants all persons unknown,
claiming any legal or equitable right, title, estate, lien, or interest in the property
described in
the complaint adverse to plaintiff's title or any cloud on plaintiff's title thereto and DOES
1 through 10, inclusive, and therefore sues them by those fictitious names. The names,
capacities and relationships of DOES 1 through 10 will be alleged by amendment to this
complaint when they are known [Optionally, in addition to language in
charging allegations that includes fictitiously named defendants. Plaintiff is informed
and believes and on that basis alleges that each of the DOE defendants claims, or may
claim, some interest in the real property described in paragraph of this
complaint.]
4. Plaintiff is the owner by adverse possession of real property located in
County, California and more specifically described as: [set

5. Plaintiff has possession of all real property described in paragraph 4 of this
complaint by actual, open, hostile, continuous, and exclusive possession.
6. Plaintiff's possession has been actual, open, hostile, continuous, and exclusive

Procedure sections 318, 319, 321-323.
7. Plaintiff has been in possession of the real property described in paragraph 4

8. Plaintiff has been in continuous possession during the 5-year period described

adverse to plaintiff.
WHEREFORE, plaintiff demands judgment against defendants as follows:
1. For judgment that plaintiff is the fee simple owner of all right, title, and
interest in and to the described real property;
2. For judgment that defendants do not have any right, title, estate, or
interest in or lien on the described real property;
3. For such further relief as the court may deem proper.
